TAKE A LOOK AT THE LOOK BACK LAW

For many survivors of childhood sexual abuse, the effects of trauma can make it difficult to come forward for years—even decades. Recognizing this reality, Louisiana created the Child Sexual Abuse Lookback Law, giving many survivors whose claims had previously expired a renewed opportunity to pursue civil justice.

This law was recently at the center of the Lockridge case, where Ryan E. Gatti Law Firm represented survivor Pamela Lockridge. A Bossier Parish jury returned a \$1.1 billion verdict, the largest single-plaintiff civil verdict in Louisiana history, demonstrating the importance of allowing survivors to have their voices heard.

While every case is unique, the Lookback Law provides hope for survivors who once believed it was too late to seek justice.

If you or someone you know experienced childhood sexual abuse in Louisiana, it may still be possible to explore your legal options before the June 14, 2027 deadline.
